# Who is EBH?

EBH stands for Emergency Behavioral Health.

EBH Members are trained in various crisis response modalities to assist with mitigating the impact of stress from a critical event. These can include; EBH, CISM, PFA, or specialty response.

They provide services to individuals impacted by critical incidents both natural or manmade.



# Where would EBH deploy?

EBH can deploy to:

- Emergency Operations Center (EOC)
- Community
- Schools
- Accident and fire events
- Exercises and drills
- First Responder Support (Police, Fire & EMS)
- Anywhere a critical incident has occurred and there is a need.



# What can EBH provide?



## EBH Would

- Provide community outreach, support, education and resource assistance.
- Assess psychological impact of the critical incident to individuals and groups.
- Schedule debriefings on an as needed basis
